

Torrens Valley Rams Junior Soccer Club

If you are new to the Torrens Valley Rams Soccer Club then WELCOME!

Please find following some general information to welcome you and hopefully answer any questions that you may have about the club and procedures.

Toilets	<p>Currently the only toilets available are located across the oval (between the Soccer pitch and the Football pitch)</p> <p>They should be unlocked at the commencement of training and on game days, if for any reason they are not please ask a committee member for assistance.</p>
Which team to join?	<p>Your child should be in the team that is above their age,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have children of different ages that you would like in the same team then an approach must be made to the Registrar and the team coach with reasons explaining why you seek an exemption. • Final placement will depend on team numbers.
Training	<p>Our 2017 soccer season will have all Junior club members training on a Tuesday night - commencing from 5pm onwards, your coach will confirm the actual time.</p> <p>All team members are expected to attend training. If for any reason your child is unable to attend please advise your coach / team manager.</p> <p>If training needs to be cancelled due to bad weather then your coach / team manager will notify you - if there is only a small or moderate amount of rain then training <u>will proceed as normal.</u></p>
Uniforms	<p>All players must be in club uniform by the commencement of matches. This consists of: <u>Torrens Valley Club Shirt (aka Strip) Club Shorts and Club Socks.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A club strip will be provided to each team member for the duration of the season - this must be returned to the club on presentation day. • Shorts and Socks can be purchased from a committee member in the club rooms for \$20 shorts & \$15 socks • The club also have weather proof winter Jackets with the TVSC Logo available for \$60 • Also available are TVSC Junior & Senior Hoodies available with your child's name on the back - please place your orders through Glenda for these @ ~\$50 • Your child will also be required to purchase their own (not from the club) SHIN Pads for protection. Referees will not let them play unless they are wearing them. <p>(If you would like to check out any second hand soccer boots, they will be available for a donation op swap with the other uniform gear)</p>
Matches	<p>The first match for the season is the last weekend in April.</p>

	<p>Once the season starts we play each Saturday until the end, school holiday break included. Once the season begins you will be able to log onto Adelaide Hills Junior Soccer Association ahjsa.com.au to confirm match locations and time. These are subject to change from time to time so please always check the week before your match.</p> <p>Matches can start as early as 8am (with a 7.30am warm up) and proceed through the morning. We play Adelaide Hills teams which range from us at Torrens Valley to places such as Mannum, Murray Bridge, through to Strathalbyn.</p>
Match Day	<p>For any of the first match of the day played at home, the Coach has to set up such things as goals, flags, cones, etc and similarly pack them all away if its the last game of the day. They always appreciated another couple of hands for this job.</p>
Match & Training Support	<p>It is important for parents to attend training with their children, if you can encourage them and explain that their coach is in charge during training and match day and that they must be treated with respect and listened to. Sideline support from parents is so encouraging for the teams on match day. Please note that all clubs have a code of conduct for spectators and parents must always keep their comments positive.</p> <p>Photography is allowed, but as a courtesy ask parents if taking their children. We love to see our kids on the TVSC & AHJSA website, so please submit REDUCED size photos to our webmaster for publishing.</p> <p>A team report MUST be written and submitted by each team - your manager will let you know - this is submitted to the AHJSA for publishing in the Courier, so if you are a happy snapper, send in your photos to your manager.</p>
Bullying	<p>Torrens Valley Soccer Club is does not tolerate Bullying. If you feel your child is being treated unfairly by another team member please approach your Coach immediately. If you are not satisfied with the outcome please contact our Child Safety Officer, Elly Deane-Freeman</p> <p>It is important that all children enjoy their time experiencing and playing soccer for Torrens Valley.</p>
Club Fees	<p>Your fees must be paid in full before your child begins playing matches. If you have concerns or questions please see the Treasurer or Registrar.</p>
Registration	<p>Before your child begins playing matches you must log onto http://myfootballclub.com.au/index.php?id=38 and register your child.</p>
Canteen	<p>Our canteen should be up and running each Tuesday night with a selection of snacks, tea, coffee, cold drinks and occasionally hot chips.</p> <p>If you are available to help Leanne (canteen manager) on a Tuesday, pop in and offer.</p> <p>The canteen and BBQ will also operate each Saturday for matches played at home. You will be rostered a turn by your team manager.</p>
Rosters	<p>Your team manager / coach will provide parents (of the team members) with a roster to supply Oranges and Lollies for each game and to run the canteen at any home games - if you need to change your rostered date please deal direct with your team manager.</p>

Carnival	Adelaide Hills Junior Soccer Association runs a soccer carnival in September each year - the dates will be announced closer to the time but the day is always a Saturday and each team will be entered in the carnival. Each team will play approx. 4 short games and it is a great day out for all the kids.
Dates to Remember	<p>Rock and Roll Rendezvous 9th April 2017 Bay to Birdwood September 2017</p> <p>Please support the club by keeping an hour or two free on these dates to help cook a burger or serve a cold coke - all funds raised go directly back into the club and these are the main fundraisers that we have that we ask for your help.</p> <p>If you can't help on the day - ANY Help would be appreciated the day before to collect bread, set up the BBQ, etc.</p>
Presentation Day / AGM	<p>This is generally held on a Sunday afternoon at the end of the season. The club provides a sausage and drink for all players before the trophies are presented.</p> <p>As soon as this date becomes available we will publish it.</p>
